RING SIZER

This ring sizer allows you to measure your finger at home. A few tips to ensure a perfect fit:


- Make sure your finger is at a normal body temperature. Your fingers size shrinks when it is cold and expands when it is hot.
- Measure your finger at the end of the day when its typically the largest.
- If your knuckle is much larger than your finger's base, take two separate measurements and choose a size in between. You want a ring to fit over your knuckle, but not be too loose where it will shift around.
- If you are in between sizes, opt for the larger size.
- Bands and rings over 5mm may fit your finger more tightly than rings of the same size in narrower widths.

STEPS

1. Download and Print the Ring Sizer: Download the ring sizer template from the Raz & Company website.

Print the template at 100% scale, ensuring no resizing. Verify the scale with a ruler (e.g., a 1-inch or 30-mm reference line).

- 2. Cut Out the Ring Sizer: Carefully cut out the ring sizer along the provided lines.
- 3. Prepare the Ring Sizer: Make a small slit in the marked area on the ring sizer.
- 4. Measure Your Finger: Insert the pointed end of the sizer through the slit to form a loop. Place the loop around the base of the finger you intend to wear the ring on. Pull the pointed end until the sizer fits snugly but comfortably around your finger.
- 5. Read the Size: Note the number indicated at the slit to determine your ring size



Ensure the tape or paper is snug but not tight, allowing for comfort.

- Mark and Measure: Mark the point where the tape or paper meets.
 If using a strip of paper, measure the length from the end to the marked point with a ruler.
- 4. **Determine Your Size**: Refer to our ring size chart to convert your measurement to the corresponding ring size.

MEASURE YOUR CURRENT RING


To find the perfect ring size, you can measure an existing ring that fits well. Here's how to do it:

STEPS

- **1. Select a Well-Fitting Ring**: Choose a ring that fits comfortably on the finger you intend to wear the new ring on.
- 2. **Print a Ring Size Chart:** Print the chart at 100% scale with no resizing. Use a ruler with the guide below to ensure your chart is printed to scale.
- 3. Match the Ring to the Chart: Place the ring over the circles on the printed ring size chart. Align the inside edge of the ring with the circles on the chart to find the size where the circle fits perfectly within the ring.

Tips for Accurate Measurement:

- The ring should match the circle on the chart exactly, with the circle's edges touching the inside of the ring without overlapping.
- Measure several times to ensure accuracy.
- If the ring falls between two sizes, choose the larger size for comfort.
